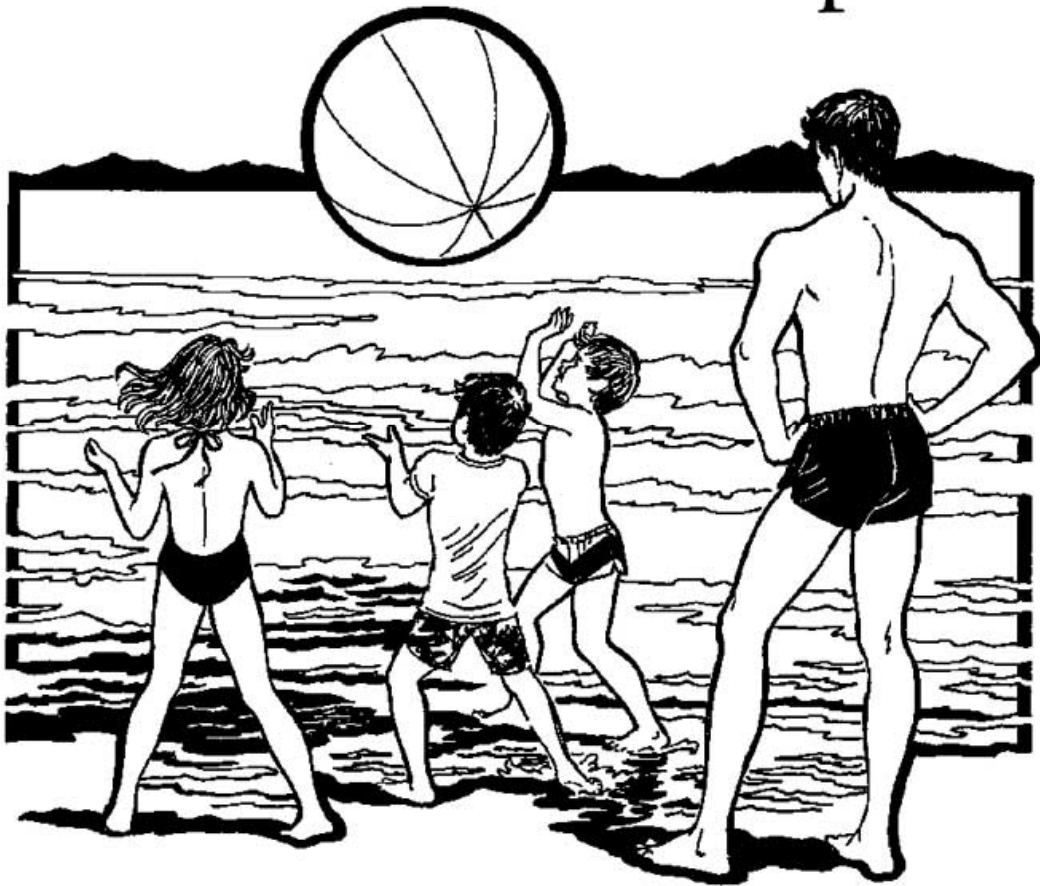

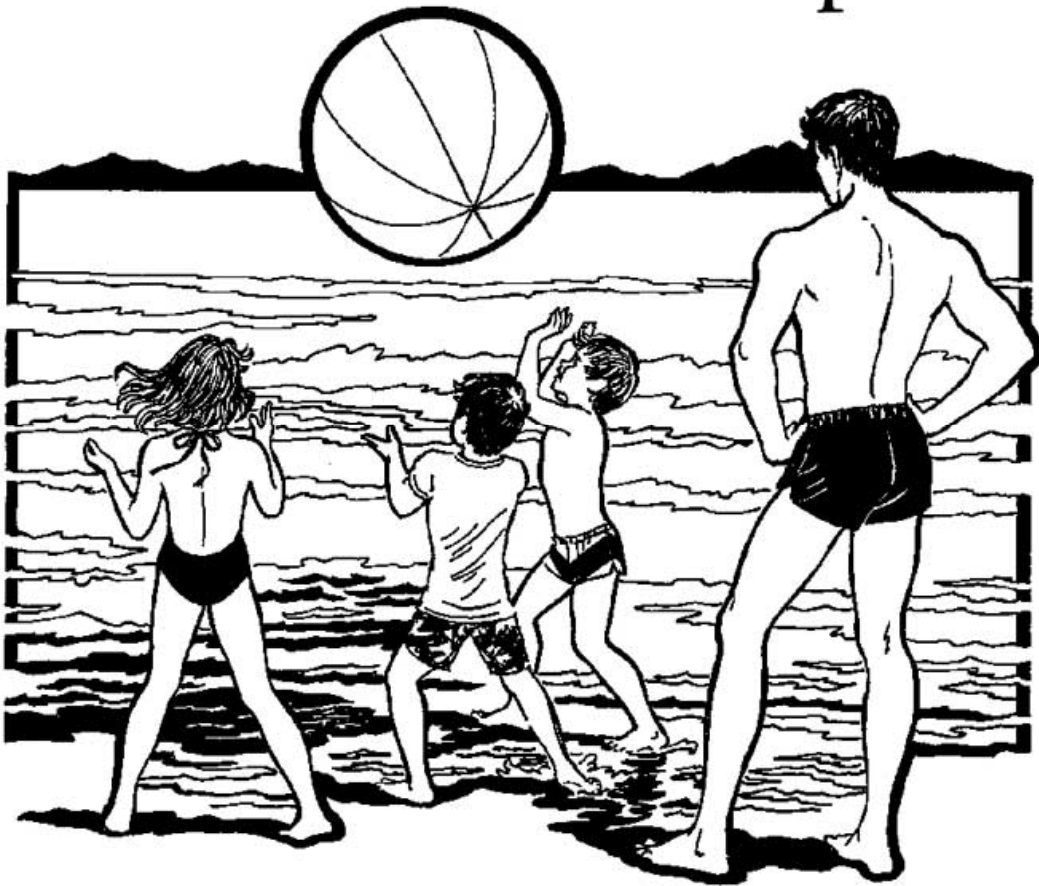

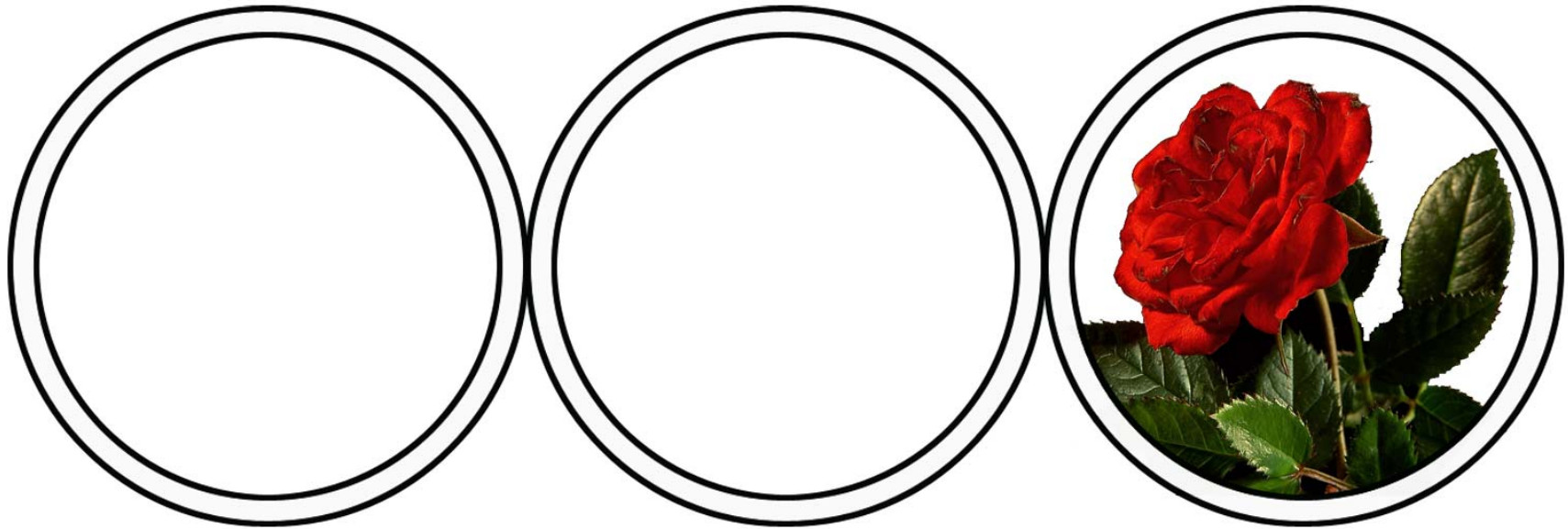
Cut out table on the next page. Fold in half and glue the title above onto the cover.

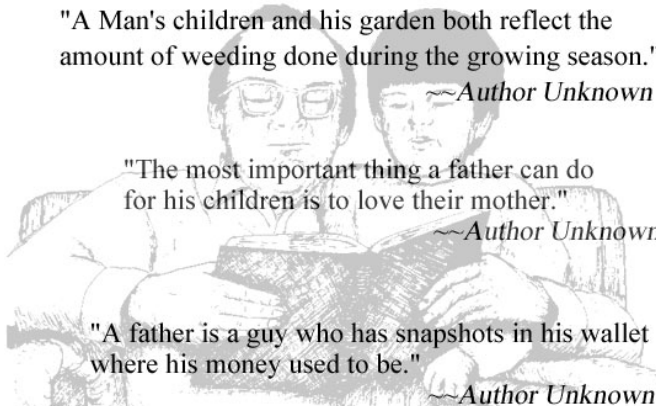

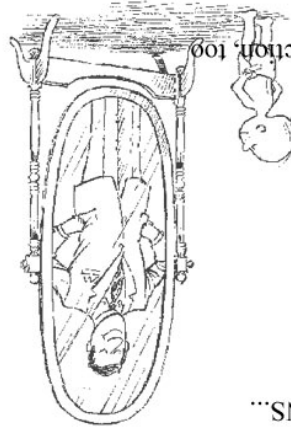
