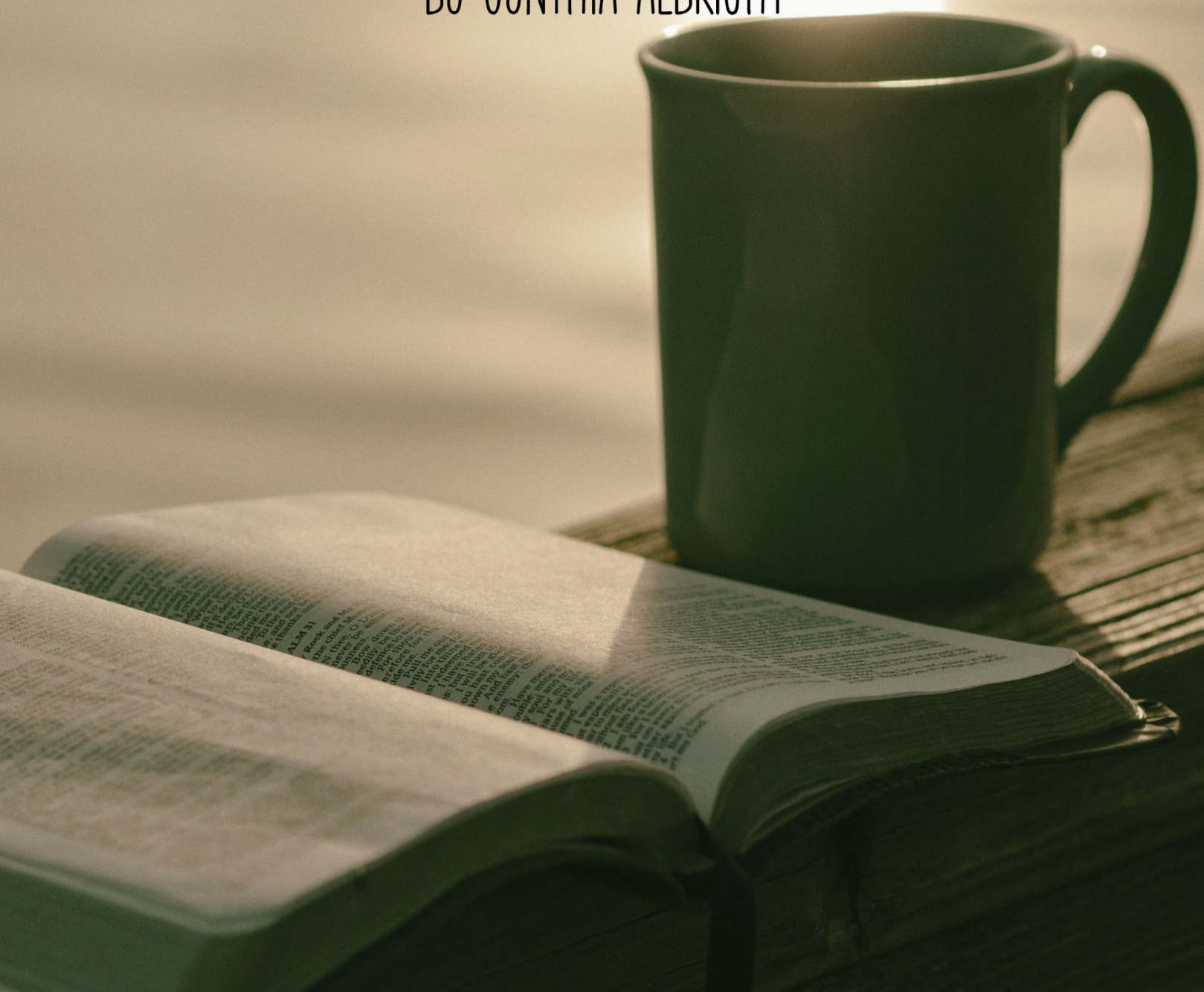

The One Year Bible Reading Plan Journal is a great way for you to write down your thoughts as you read your bible through the year.

The reading schedule is broken down by week and then by day. I left it undated so that you can start any time during the year.

I like to begin my bible time with a Psalm which you will go through the first six months of the year. I also read a Proverb a day during the first month of my reading schedule.

After reading my bible through a few times utilizing the One Year Bible, I found that I do not like to read a bit of the Old Testament and a bit of the New Testament each day with a Psalm and a portion of a Proverb.

I like to read one book at a time, so I alternate between the Old and New Testaments. I begin with Genesis and then proceed to Matthew, then back to Exodus, and then on to Mark, etc.

As I read, I underline or make notes in the margins of my bible, but with this handy journal you can record your thoughts, a bible reference, define a word, etc.

It is my prayer that the schedule and journal will bless you and your time with the Lord.
